

National Week Of Prayer For Our Street Daily Prayers

Monday 24th OCT.

"This is the day the Lord has made. We will rejoice and be glad in it."

Psalm 118:24, NLT

Spend time thanking God for all the good things in your area and in our nation:

Heavenly Father, we thank you for all your many blessings to us. Please open our eyes to see all the good things in our nation and in our communities and we thank you for each one. Amen.

Tuesday 25th OCT.

"I urge you then first of all that requests, prayer, intercession and thanksgiving be made for everyone, for kings and all those in authority that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness."

1 Timothy 2:12

Spend time praying for those in authority in our nation and in your local area:

Heavenly Father we pray for our royal family and government and ask that you give them wisdom as they lead our nation. Please bless them and guide them and may we live in a nation of peace and justice that knows you as Lord of all. Amen.

Wednesday 26th OCT

"Also seek the peace and prosperity of the city to which I have sent you. Pray to the lord for it, because if it prospers, you too will prosper."

Jeremiah 29:7

Spend time praying for the peace and prosperity of our nation and a way out of the economic crisis:

Heavenly Father, we pray for your blessing on the economic state of our nation and that you give wisdom to those responsible for leading us out of the recession. We pray for your peace in our towns and nation. Amen.

Thursday 27th OCT

"For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you and asking God to fill you with the knowledge of his will through all spiritual wisdom and understanding. And we pray this in order that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and may please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God, being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience, and joyfully giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance.... in the kingdom of light."

Spend time praying for other street pastor groups, Christians everywhere in our nation (i.e. the church family) and then families throughout our nation:

Friday 28th OCT

"He replied, "Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and obey it."

Luke 11:28

Spend time praying that God would show us His will and that we would be obedient to it. Ask him what He wants you to do both personally and as the church in your town:

Heavenly Father, we pray that we would seek your will and that we can hear your voice. Help us to truthfully pray the line in the lords prayer thy kingdom come thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Please show us what it means to live like that so we can live under your blessing. Amen

Saturday 29th OCT

"May God be gracious to us and bless us and make his face shine upon us, that your ways may be known on earth, your salvation among all nations."

Spend time asking for God to bless your town and our nation

Heavenly Father, we ask for your blessing on our nation and that we walk in your ways. Amen

Sunday 30th OCT

"Give us each day our daily bread."

Matthew 11:2 NIV

Spend time asking God for your needs and for the needs in our nation and towns.

Heavenly Father, we thank you that you provide for our needs and we ask you to supply our needs each day. We pray not just for our own needs but for those of our area and our nation. Amen

Monday 31st OCT

"And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil."

Luke 11:4 KJV

Spend time asking for the safety of all those affected by Halloween

Heavenly Father, we ask that you protect those who are out trick or treating tonight and that you keep them safe and that you also protect those who are scared by people knocking on their door unexpectedly. Especially be with the elderly and those living on their own. Amen
