CURRICULUM

To Every Believer,

There is much talk, currently, going on in the Church about prayer, as more and more people are realising and acknowledging the need for Christians to pray. Various prayer groups and initiatives are springing up, as the sense of urgency for prayer increases.

However, many who desire to pray are struggling and finding it difficult to do so effectively. Many simply do not know how to pray or what to pray about; others pray with a lack of depth, faith, conviction and fervency; whilst some even pray in conflict with God's word. Many are also perplexed and discouraged by their unanswered prayers

The Lord desires and commands us to pray, therefore, prayer is a priority, and must be the basis of everything we do. Prayer is not the only discipline we engage in as Christian, but prayer must undergird everything we do. Weak praying makes weak individuals and churches. We are powerless and ineffective when we are prayerless. The lack of earnest prayer has produced a deficit of power in the Church in the UK.

The Prayer Training Institute has been set up to de-mystify prayer and make it practicable to the believer. We aim to achieve this through simple, clear and biblical teachings, designed to help the believer engage in effective prayer.
